

1 CHILDREN'S TRUST OF ALACHUA COUNTY  
2 RESOLUTION No. 2020-1  
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4 WHEREAS the Children's Trust of Alachua County was established by Alachua County  
5 Ordinance 18-08 which was adopted by the voters of Alachua County on November 6, 2018, and

6 WHEREAS, the Children's Trust of Alachua County is required by its enabling law to employ an  
7 Executive Director; and

8 WHEREAS, the Children's Trust of Alachua County is an Independent Special District and has  
9 chosen to participate in the Florida Retirement System, and

10 WHEREAS, the Children's Trust of Alachua County (the "Trust"), the Alachua County Board of  
11 County Commissioners (the "County") and the Clerk of Court (the "Clerk") have entered into an  
12 interlocal agreement (the "Interlocal" which provides that the County will employ the Trust's employees  
13 in accordance with County Personnel Policy 4-2(1.e), and the Trust will reimburse the County for all  
14 expenses related to those employees, and

15 WHEREAS, the Trust has employed Colin Murphy as its Executive Director and wishes to have  
16 him enrolled in the Senior Management Class of the Florida Retirement System which is appropriate for  
17 his position as an executive director of an Independent Special District, and

18 WHEREAS, the Trust has been advised by the Clerk of Court that so long as the Executive  
19 Director is being paid according to County Personnel Policy 4-2(1.e), he must be reported under the  
20 County's FRS report, and

21 WHEREAS, the County currently has three unassigned Senior Management designations  
22 available, and

23 WHEREAS, the Trust wishes to request the Board of County Commissioners allocate one of its  
24 available Senior Management designations for the use of the Trust's Executive Director as long as the  
25 Executive Director remains a County employee under County Personnel Policy 4-2(1.e).

26 IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CHILDREN'S TRUST OF ALACHUA COUNTY AS  
27 FOLLOWS:

- 28 1. The Board of County Commissioners is respectfully requested to allocate one of its available  
29 open Senior Management designations to the Trust Executive Director, so long as the Executive  
30 Director remains on the County payroll.  
31 2. The Executive Director is authorized to negotiate any changes to the Interlocal that may be  
32 required as a result of the action of the County.  
33 3. The Interim Chair or his Designee is authorized to deliver this to the Chair of the Board of the  
34 County Commissioners at the earliest opportunity.


